



GESCHN Mobile Paediatric Emergency Training

Target Audience

Frontline medical and nursing staff (especially junior staff and those with infrequent exposure) caring for sick children in the emergency department, operating theatre, intensive care unit or paediatric ward.

Prerequisites

- Must be employed within the NSW - GESCHN area.

Description

Format

A series of three half-day training workshops addressing management of sick children, team work and communication. Participants may apply for one or more themed workshops.

W1 - The deteriorating child and paediatric resuscitation

W2 - The child with breathing difficulties

W3 - The child with trauma

Aims

Team-based care of acutely ill children

Specific Objectives

- A systematic approach to the sick child in the Emergency department or ward
- Team-based rehearsal of realistic problems and emergency algorithms according to theme
- Non-technical skills: teamwork, communication & safety culture.
- A child-focussed approach to care of sick children

Training Methods

- Pause and discuss scenarios & reflective debriefing
- Simulated problem based learning case simulations

Training Technologies

- Medium and high fidelity mobile manikin simulators (Marvin and Zara)
- Actors (Parents)

Other features

- The workshops have a structured curriculum and are delivered in a uniform way
- Clinical content adheres to NSW Health Paediatric Clinical Practice Guidelines
- The facilitators are clinical experts who are supported by an experienced team from the SCSSC

Maximum Participants

Maximum 12 participants per course.

Location

The University of Wollongong (Shoalhaven Campus).
