### Target Audience

Multiprofessional (Medical & Nursing) staff caring for children and babies in emergency departments and paediatric wards within NSLHD

### Prerequisites

#### Essential

- Previous training in Paediatric Basic Life Support
- Must have completed Resus4Kids
- Must work in ED or Paediatrics

### Description

#### Aims

- To prepare medical and nursing staff to recognise the progressive deterioration of the sick child/ infant.
- To respond rapidly and effectively to Paediatric Emergencies

#### Specific Objectives

- Structured approach to recognition and management of paediatric emergencies
- Clinical skills: Infant and child airway, BLS review, intraosseous cannulation
- Non-technical skills: Teamwork, leadership and communication

#### Training Methods

- Lectures
- Skills stations
- Pause and discuss scenarios
- Immersive scenarios and reflective debriefs

#### Training Technologies

- Task trainers
- Medium and high fidelity manikin simulators
- Actors (Parents)

1 day course (0800 – 1630 hours)
